

RN Negotiations Update #6 June 10, 2014

Friday UNOCH and RCHSD met for our fourth negotiating session. There were nine economic proposals for UNOCH to consider. The wage increases offered by RCHSD are characteristically low- but first offers are traditionally considered "throw-aways" and not a true indication of what the final increases will be.

The hospital also had a number of "take- away" proposals such as doubling the per diem commitment, not considering call back hours over-time, and others.

UNOCH wants our membership to remember that our contract is a mature contract now and we are not interested in going backwards. Those proposals will be rejected by UNOCH.

RCHSD had a whole list of take-aways during the recent Tech. negotiations that UNOCH rejected after the ever popular 8 hour threat failed, *once again*, to work.
